Definitions: Turn in, brake point, apex, track out, early, late, over steer, under steer.						
Proper seat, mirrors, and driving position . Proper hand positions and hand movement on the steering wheel.						
Awareness: Hand signals to other drivers, use of mirrors, reads traffic - for passing/being passed.						
Knowledge of the course and the proper driving line . Knows how to enter and exit all turns.						
Head and eyes level: Looking ahead and into the turn/past apex. Scans entire visual field.						
Car Control: Demonstrates proper recovery techniques, knows principles of vehicle dynamics, & smoothness.						
Braking: Threshold/ABS braking. Hard and late on straights. Understands trail braking.						
Shifting: Rev matching, heel/toe downshifting, selecting proper gear, observes redline, doesn't ride clutch.
